

Veterans Day

Veterans Day is a U.S. federal holiday observed annually on November 11 to honor all American veterans who have served in the United States Armed Forces. Unlike Memorial Day, which honors those who died in service, Veterans Day recognizes all veterans, living or deceased.

The holiday originated as Armistice Day to mark the end of World War I. Major hostilities ceased on November 11, 1918, at the 11th hour. President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the first Armistice Day in 1919, and it became a federal holiday in 1938. Following World War II and the Korean War, it was expanded to honor all veterans and renamed Veterans Day in 1954 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower. While briefly moved to a Monday in October by the Uniform Monday Holiday Act in 1968, it was returned to November 11 in 1978. [Info Google]

According to a 2023 study from the Department of Veterans, men and women who have served in the military have higher suicide rates and bouts with cancer than non-veterans. In addition, many Vets have difficulty adjusting to civilian life, as well as other physical, emotional and spiritual challenges.
