On that day you are to tell your son,
"It is because of what Adonai did for me
when I left Egypt."

G-D gave instructions and reasons for remembering and celebrating the Feast of Passover. One thing to remember was the day on which you left the abode of slavery because Adonai, by the strength of his hand, has brought you out of that place.

Every year we partake of the Passover Seder and remember the history of G-D's people miraculously leaving Egypt, and I think many of us can see the foreshadowing of Yeshua bringing each of us out of the clutches of the kingdom of darkness and bondage to sin.

Since we now live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. G-D is showing us a pattern to follow to declare what G-D did for us on that day when we turned from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to G-D, so that we could receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Yeshua. (Acts 26:18)

Our testimonies should include:

- 1. How Yeshua drew us to Himself;
- 2. The moment of our deliverance;
- 3. Ways our life changed since then.
 I encourage each of us to write our testimony and practice telling it, trying to keep it to 3 or 4 minutes. Equip yourself to declare what Adonai did for you in a way that will glorify His power and reality.
