"Yitro" Sh'mot 18:8

Moshe told his father-in-law all that Adonai had done to Pharaoh and the Egyptians for Israel's sake, all the hardships they had suffered while traveling and how Adonai had rescued them.

"Power in a Seed"

Look at any little seed. Unless you are familiar with seeds you would not know what fruit that seed will produce. G-D designed even the tiniest seed to carry within it all the nature and characteristics to reproduce the exact same "fruit" from which it came...and with tons of seeds that would also produce the same results...all from just one seed!

Your spoken words that testify the deeds G-D has done in your life are also seeds that can produce faith in another who hears your words. Sometimes the soil of the hearer is ready for those seeds to bear fruit. Some are not. In the

Kingdom of G-D we are called to sow the seeds, not judge if the hearer is ready to hear. Our responsibility is to sow the seeds. To do that we must speak of the great things G-D has done in our lives, just like Moses did:

"Upon hearing of all G-D had done to Egypt in order to free His people, Yitro turned away from the pagan gods he had served and returned to the faith of his ancestor, Abraham." (Yitro was descended from Abraham through Abraham's third wife, Keturah. Gen. 25:1-2) Yitro confessed, "Now I know that Adonai is greater than all other gods because He rescued those who were treated so arrogantly." He then brought a burnt offering (dedicating himself whole heartedly to Adonai) and sacrifices to G-D. Aharon came with all the leaders of Israel to share the meal before G-D with Moshe's father-in-law. Ex.18:10=12.

From what has G-D freed you lately? How has G-D changed you on the inside, manifesting in changed behavior on the outside? Are you working out your salvation with fear and trembling? In what way(s) are you different now than you were last month? Just having more knowledge is good, but transformation is essential evidence of your union with Adonai. Share those testimonies of G-D's victories over battles in your life, sowing seeds of life into the fields ready (or not) for harvest. Be found laboring together with Him, rescuing those who are being treated so arrogantly by the enemy of our souls.
