
Purim 2026 🎉



Purim commemorates the Divinely orchestrated salvation of the Jewish people in the ancient Persian empire from Haman's plot "to destroy, kill and annihilate all the Jews...young and old, infants and women." Purim was thus named since Haman had thrown lots to determine when he would carry out his diabolical scheme, as recorded in the book of Esther.

**Pesach (Passover) - April 1**

KBA will hold its annual Passover seder on Wednesday, April 1. This year’s location is the clubhouse at 5001 Mainstreet Park Drive, Stone Mountain, Georgia 30088. Check-in starts at 7:00 p.m., and the seder will begin promptly at 7:30 p.m. Cost is \$35/adult and \$15/child (12 and under).

Please note that due to space limitations we will not be able to accommodate more than 50 people; therefore, to ensure everyone from KBA who wants to participate is able to do so, we are limiting attendance to our KBA family. As clarification, by "KBA family" we mean those who worship with us on *Shabbat* regardless of membership status.

A sign-up sheet will be at the back of the sanctuary each *Shabbat* for the next few weeks. If you plan to attend, we encourage you to go ahead and sign up. Once we reach a total attendance of 50, we will not be able to accept anyone else, although we will keep a wait list in case someone cancels.
