

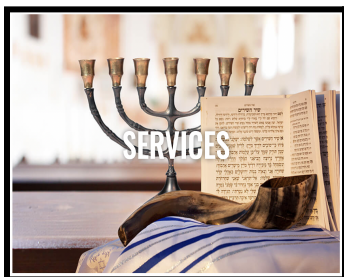

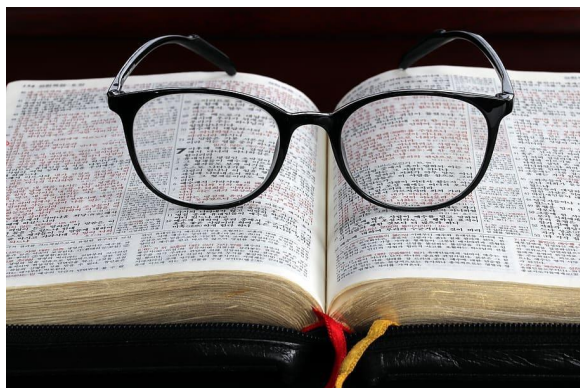

Sukkot evening activity and cookout: Tuesday, September 29. Details TBA soon.

Shemini Atzeret/Simchat Torah: Saturday, October 3, at 11:00 a.m.
